CAMP OVERVIEW: Camp Crescendo is a therapeutic arts summer program for children with Down Syndrome and their families who are affiliated with Upside of Downs. As well, Camp Crescendo will be collaborating with a local organization to offer music therapy to young autistic children. Through music, art, movement, and storytelling, campers will not only gain confidence with important developmental, social, and academic skills in a fun and engaging way, but they will also strengthen their bond and make memories with caregivers and friends new and old.

JOB SUMMARY: The Camp Counselor will provide support in all aspects of camp. Whether assisting a child play an instrument or sanitizing equipment, preparing materials for an art project or reading a story, the camp counselor helps camp flow. Additionally, they will help with logistics like welcoming campers and grown-ups, setting up spaces, and cleaning up. The ideal candidate is an energetic person who loves the arts, anticipates the needs of others, and finds fulfillment in engaging in the arts with others. This would be an amazing opportunity for a university student who is on a path to be an educator, social worker, occupational therapist, speech and language pathologist, or expressive arts therapist.
