HOURS/SCHEDULE

- Orientation during the week of June 9; time and date to be determined
- Monday, June 16, 2025 Thursday, June 19, 2025; 8:30 AM 12:30 PM
- Volunteers could come for just one or two mornings of the week.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complete general orientation to Camp Crescendo with Program Director.
- Maintain confidentiality of campers and their families.
- Greet and welcome campers coming to the Knox Music Institute.
- Assist with set-up and break down for groups (moving chairs, sanitizing instruments, storing instruments).
- Attend sessions and assist/support participants as discussed/directed by Music Therapist [see note below].
- Escort groups as they exit the Knox Music Institute and the Miller Theater.
- Communicate promptly and openly with Music Therapist about scheduling and availability.

SKILLS & ABILITIES

- No musical training or experience required; music appreciation desired!
- Openness to children with Down Syndrome and autism.
- Strength-based mindset is a must.
- Willingness to participate musically in groups is helpful (sing with the group, play a drum, etc); however, expectations can be aligned upon interview.
